2009 Blue Slide Camp Report

The theme for Blue Slide 2009 was "Walk Your Talk". The theme verse was from Psalm 19:14, "May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer". Wes and Britter Kinsey came out from Mississippi to assist in the directing of the camp this year. I allowed Wes to take the reins and run while I helped on the peripheral. Between them and Jennifer and me, we were a pretty good team as our wives were great support. This was a trial to see if Wes and Britter would be willing to take on the full task of directing Blue Slide in 2010. This was my 11th year involved with camp, 8 of them as the director. I've been appointed Administrative Director of the NCBA camp ministry to include both Children and Youth so this would allow me to concentrate my efforts making both camps successful.

Camp Pastor Kevin Webb from Hillsboro, OR challenged the campers each night to not only talk about serving God but to show it through their actions. 116 campers and 40 staff attended camp this year. It was the largest camp in nearly 10 years. Thankfully new cabins and bathroom facilities have been added since then so we were able to house everyone. With all the family members and kids the kitchen staff fed 171 people three meals a day for four days. Unofficially there were 6 new professions of faith during the week and many more commitments to have a better walk. Unlike previous years, there were no mountain lion sightings this year. We attribute that in part to the additional lighting that was installed around the camp facility to illuminate the grounds for safety purposes. This proved to be very beneficial and served its purpose well.

For fear that I might forget someone; I just want to thank everyone who had a part in making Blue Slide 2009 a huge ministry success.
